Twelve EXTRA RULES to Keep us Safe

- I will stay **2 metres** away from everyone. There will be marking to help.
- I will use the **toilets only one at a time**.
- I will **wash my hands** with **soap** or **sanitiser** for **20 seconds** (you can sing Happy Birthday twice to check).
- I will **Catch It, Bin It, Kill It** when I cough or sneeze. This means coughing or sneezing into a **tissue**, putting the tissue into a **bin**, then **washing my hands**. I will bring my own pack of tissues to use.
- I will use my **own water bottle** and bring it with me every day.
- I will **bring my own lunch and snack** and will not share it.

- I will stay in my **special space** when indoors, a space which is just for me. If I need an adult, I will **put up my hand** so they will come to me.
- **Everything I bring** for the day will be kept in my special space.
- I will **stay in the areas for my bubble** when outside, and not go into the areas for other bubbles.
- I will wear **clean clothes every day** to come to FUNdays Club.
- I will **listen carefully to instructions** from adults because they are trying to keep everyone safe.
- I will **follow instructions carefully**, because they are about keeping everyone safe.
